**DR. TONY CAMPOLO**, professor emeritus of Sociology at Eastern University in Pennsylvania, served for 20 years on the faculty of the University of Pennsylvania. A graduate of Eastern College, he earned a Ph.D. from Temple University.

Founder and president of the Evangelical Association for the Promotion of Education, he has worked to create and support programs for "at-risk" children in cities across North America, and has helped establish schools and universities in several developing countries.

The author of 32 books, Dr. Campolo is a media commentator on religious, social and political matters, including appearances on "Nightline," "Crossfire" and "CNN News." He hosts a weekly program on the Premier Radio Network in England.

Dr. Campolo is an ordained minister, has served American Baptist Churches in New Jersey and Pennsylvania, and is presently an associate pastor of the Mount Carmel Baptist Church in West Philadelphia.
