The Mercer Preaching Consultation 2007 offers an extraordinary lineup of speakers that you will want to hear. Scheduled for September 23-25 at the King and Prince Beach and Golf Resort, St. Simons Island, Georgia, this year's program is expected to be one of our best!

Attendance at this annual event is limited to just 200 participants. Because of your continued support to the McAfee School of Theology and The Center for Baptist Studies, we want to give you the first opportunity to register.

The Rev. Barbara Brown Taylor will be our main presenter, who will speak each day of the three-day series. An Episcopal priest, she spent 15 years in parish ministry before becoming a full-time teacher of religion in 1997 at Piedmont College in the foothills of the Appalachian Mountains. In a 2006 profile on PBS's popular "Religion and Ethics" series, she was described as "one of this country's most eloquent preachers." Among her 11 books are *Leaving Church*, 2006; *The Seeds of Heaven*, 2004; *Speaking of Sin*, 2000; *Home By Another Way*, 1999; *When God Is Silent*, 1998, and *The Preaching Life*, 1993.

Following the Sunday evening program, Mercer President William D. Underwood is sponsoring a buffet dinner for everyone attending. It will give us an opportunity to gather and fellowship with one another.

Mr. L. C. Lane of Music Horizons Ministry in Newnan, Georgia, will provide music. For more than 23 years, Mr. Lane was minister of music at the First Baptist Church of Newnan before retiring from his ministry position in 2000 to pursue a successful ministry in singing, playing and composing.

Registration is \$100 per individual (\$200 per couple) and is on a first-come, first-served basis. We have reserved a block of rooms at the King and Prince Beach and Golf Resort, 201 Arnold Road, St. Simons Island, Ga. 31522. Rooms begin at \$145 per night, single or double. Rooms will be reserved on a first-come, first served basis.

We also have reserved rooms at the Hampton Inn, (912) 634-2204, at \$119 per night, and the Holiday Inn Express, (912) 634-2175, at \$88 per night, both of which include breakfast and double occupancy. The deadline for room reservations at these special prices at these hotels is August 23.

A golf outing is planned for Monday afternoon at The Hamptons Golf Course. Registration is \$79.50, which includes all taxes and a box lunch.
